In recent years, the Alumni Committee has seen a decrease in the funding we receive from dues and scholarship donations. Even though attendence on Alumni weekend has increased recently, it is significantly less than what we had years ago. Therefore, the Alumni Committee is especially appreciative for the generous donations, made by its members. These financial contributions enable us to continue the traditions of the past and assist BHS in its current endeavors. We would like to provide you with an update regarding how your monies are being spent.

Obviously, scholarships are awarded annually, from the scholarship fund. The Alumni fund covers expenses incurred during Alumni Weekend, including the costs of the dinners for new graduates, and the 50th anniversary class, and the printing and mailing of the newsletter. In addition, we provide financial support for the Close Up Program and the Athletic Hall/Wall of Fame Banquet. We purchase an ad in the OVAC game program, in recognition of our Queen, players, and band members. We provide pizza for our Alumni Band, when they perform. We also have purchased a bench for the schoolyard, and commemorative bricks for the new school and Rotary shelter near the softball field.

The Committee has participated in several fundraisers, to supplement donations, from our Alumni. Heidi French '89, has done a great job coordinating a Chinese Auction, during Alumni Weekend, which allows us to have a successful Friday Night event. Some of the other fundraisers we sponsored, include: a night out at Denny's and Chipolte; participating in Community Days at Boscov's; and selling various Bulldog memorabilia at sporting events.

As a community activity, we have participated in the Bridgeport Christmas parade, distributing treats to the children.
