
Generous Donation will lead to the construction of an Exercise Science Center on School campus.

A generous donation from Alumnus and member of the Bridgeport Alumni Hall Of Fame class of 2011, Mr. Raymond Stewart '54, will lead to the construction of an Science Center in the Bridgeport Exempted Village School District.

"We're excited because we believe it's going to be a program that is going to suit and benefit the district for decades to come. Mr. Stewart's donation will be something that is going to be a brick-and-mortar building that will have lasting benefits, not just a one time purchase of something. It's going to serve a test of time and benefit students with the understanding of their human bodies and how to keep themselves healthy; and their understanding of exercise science and physiology." Zac Shutler, Bridgeport Schools Superintendent, explained.

"With the way things are set up, we don't have a home base right now for our Health and P.E. departments, so that right there will be an asset where we can continue of instruction of physical education, health and exercise science and physiology," he stressed. Students will also use this room for classroom work. The structure will include office space for the instructor, as well.

Construction is scheduled to begin in April of 2018, with a goal of the Raymond Stewart Science Center to be completed in time for the begining of the 2018-19 school year. The approximately 2,000-square-foot structure will be built in the courtyard adjacent to the cafetorium.
