Miss Schambach's science class worked in groups to illustrate different habitats. Students studied forests, rainforests, and the Arctic.





Mr. Wukeson's kindergarten and first grade art classes recently created fall and holiday masterpieces.




Third graders Cassidy, Zander, and Dionte enjoyed interactive lessons using iPads and dry-erase boards.

Thanks to a recent donation from the Pittsburgh Pirates' Clubhouse Manager, each seventh grader was given a new water bottle.


