# **SEATING CHARTS**

Depending on how you set up your seating chart, you may see the icons below on a student's desk.

æ	If you selected Show Name Pronunciation when you created the seating chart, æ displays on the student's desk if pronunciation information has been saved in StudentInformation. Click to expand the desk or hover your cursor over the icon to view the full pronunciation.
₽	If you selected Show Desk Comments when you created the seating chart, this icon displays on the student desk when you have saved a comment for the student. Click to expand the desk or hover your cursor over the icon to view the full comment.

### **PROGRESS REPORT OPTIONS**

- Daily or Period Attendance
- Assign %: Average percent for each assignment
- Class Average

- **Duplex Printing:** Each report begins on an odd page for double-sided printing
- Hide Assignments: Displays averages for each assignment type but hides other assignment details
- Hide Exempt: Hides excluded assignments
- Parent Signature Line
- Points Missing
- Student ID
- Posted to ParentAccess
- Hide Averages: Hides letter grades and percentages
- Teacher Comment: Same comment for each student

# **QUICK TIPS**

- **Do not use your browser's Back button.** Information will not save.
- Log out when you are not using GradeBook. The app times out after a period of inactivity. Save or refresh the page to reset the timer.
- Student averages displaying as question marks? On the Grading Scale Setup screen, designate the correct grading scale and check assignment mark types; make sure the grading scale is set up properly.
- Class or student not displaying? View the Class Setup screen and Class Roster screen to verify the class and student are not hidden.
- Want to set up defaults for creating assignments? On the Teacher Home Page, below Administration, click Set Up Preferences.

## POSTING TO THE WEB

- **Post to the homework web page?** Assignment Description and Due Date display on the ParentAccess Planner screen until after the due date.
- **Post marks to the web?** Assignment Description, Marks, Points Possible, and Comments display on Grade Details screen.
- **Post Homework** Allows attachments, links, and longer description; displays on the Planner screen until after the due date.
- **Class Home Page** Post messages for parents and students to view; allows attachments and links.
- **Daily Comments** When posted, they display on the ParentAccess Dashboard and the Grade Details screen.
