## January

- Complete FAFSA
- Apply to colleges if you haven't already!
- Fill out and return Scholarships.
- ***Seniors all owe \$34.00 to the district. This is the payment for your cap and gown.***
- All delinquent fees must be paid before you can receive your diploma. Check with the office to see if you still owe anything from the past four years. See Mrs. Thomas in the office to see what you might owe.

15<sup>th</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> 9 weeks begins

19<sup>th</sup> – Report cards available

31<sup>st</sup> – FAFSA should be submitted. Information is sent to colleges after this date.

## February

- Continue to work on scholarships.
- If you're planning on pursuing an apprenticeship or other technical field, see Mrs. Falcone to set up opportunities to shadow any that you might be interested in.
- Pay any delinquent/cap and gown fees. See Mrs. Thomas in the office.

9<sup>th</sup> - ***All ICU lessons still missing from 1<sup>st</sup> semester convert to an "F" grade if not submitted by this date.***

27<sup>th</sup> – Senior trip to state capitol (Columbus)

## March

- Continue to work on scholarships. There will be various due dates from outside scholarships.
- Pay any delinquent/cap and gown fees. See Mrs. Thomas in the office.
- If you applied to a college and completed your FAFSA, you will be getting your "packages" from colleges back. Discuss them with your family and choose which one fits best.

15<sup>th</sup> - Local Scholarships due!

18<sup>th</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> 9 weeks (about 2 months) begins.

22<sup>nd</sup> – Report Cards submitted.

## April

- Pay any delinquent/cap and gown fees. See Mrs. Thomas in the office.

16<sup>th</sup> – Last day to buy tickets for Prom.

19<sup>th</sup> – ***All incompletes from 3<sup>rd</sup> nine weeks convert to an "F" grade.***

26<sup>th</sup> – Prom – Students with tickets will be allowed to leave early ***unless*** they have more than 3 missing ICU assignments (already current policy with early release students).

## May
